Central Abaco Primary during the Covid19 Pandemic and post Hurricane Dorian has remained committed to providing access to education to our students in the Abaco community. To carry out this commitment classes are done virtually. However, this has proven to be challenging as many of our students are in need of devices to be actively engaged in the virtual classes.

Currently our enrollment at this time is three hundred and twenty three (323) students with some not having access to devices. We are humbly requesting assistance from the Global Empowerment Mission and its partners with acquiring sixty five (65) laptops for students and twenty (20) laptops for teachers to further aid in our commitment to providing access to education to our students in need.

As the principal of this institution, I would be responsible along with GEM's team for the distribution of the laptop devices. Parents and students will be made aware that the devices remain the property of the school and are to be returned to the school at the discretion of the Principal, or at the end of the school's academic year, so that they could be redistributed the following year.

We look forward to and thank you for any assistance rendered as we remain committed to providing access to quality education to all our students.
