## Residential building Vorzel, Kvitkova St., 33

There are 85 people in this apartment building who have returned home from refugee status in EU countries. This building was seriously damaged during the hostilities. We restored the facade, windows, doors and the entire roof.





## School №5 Bucha, Vokzalna St., 104

During the hostilities, several shells hit the roof of the building. As a result, the windows, roof, doors and heating system were replaced. This school renovation project gives the necessary education to more than 1,600 children. This school specializes in learning foreign languages.





# School №6 Blystavytsia, Soborna St., 27

During the hostilities, several shells fell near the school, and the blast damaged the windows, the roof and heating system. This school repair project gives necessary education for over 200 children.





## Lyceum №3 Horenka, Kyievskia St., 66

During the hostilities, several shells hit the school, and the blast damaged the windows and the roof. This school repair project gives necessary education for over 200 children.





## Residential building Bucha, B. Khmelnysky Blvd., 11

Restoration of an apartment building of the AMUR residential complex in Bucha, Bohdan Khmelnytsky Boulevard, building 11. There are 45 apartments and 180 residents in this building.

## Baryshivka lyceum named after M.Zerov Baryshivka, Tsentralna St., 33

In the Baryshivka lyceum named after M.Zerov in the Kyiv region has 846 students in inclusive classes. An explosive wave damaged the building where there were creative lessons.

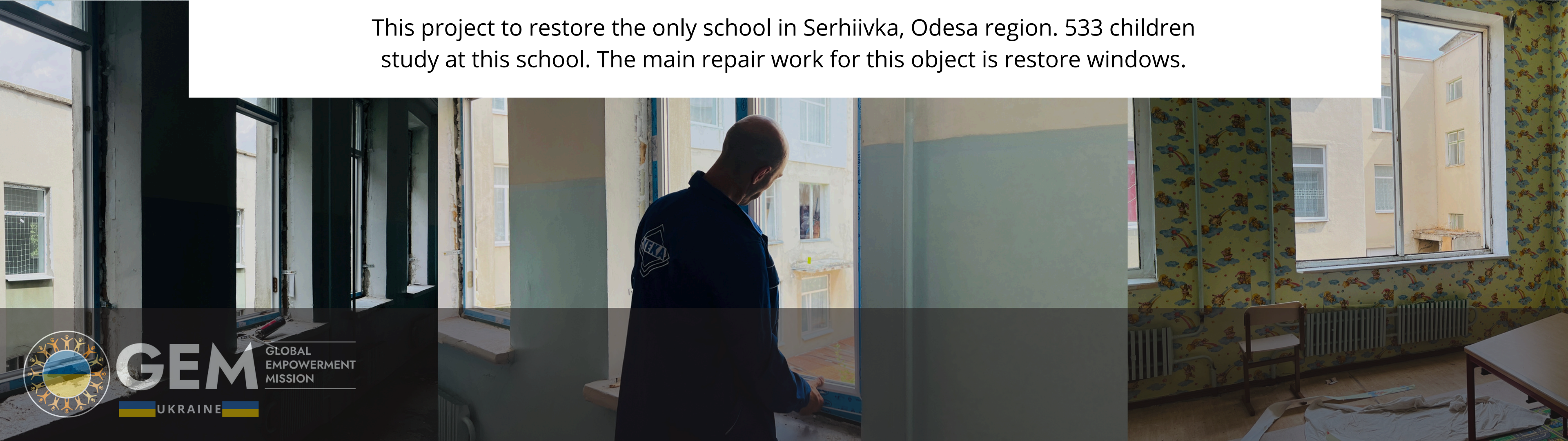
Repaired the building, restored damage and glazed windows.

Restored the building of the Sun kindergarten in Serhiivka for 130 children who visit it. 40 windows have been restored.





## Odesa - Hospital Serhiivka, Chornomorska St., 16m

This new project is to restore the outpatient department in Serhiivka,

Restored 95 windows.

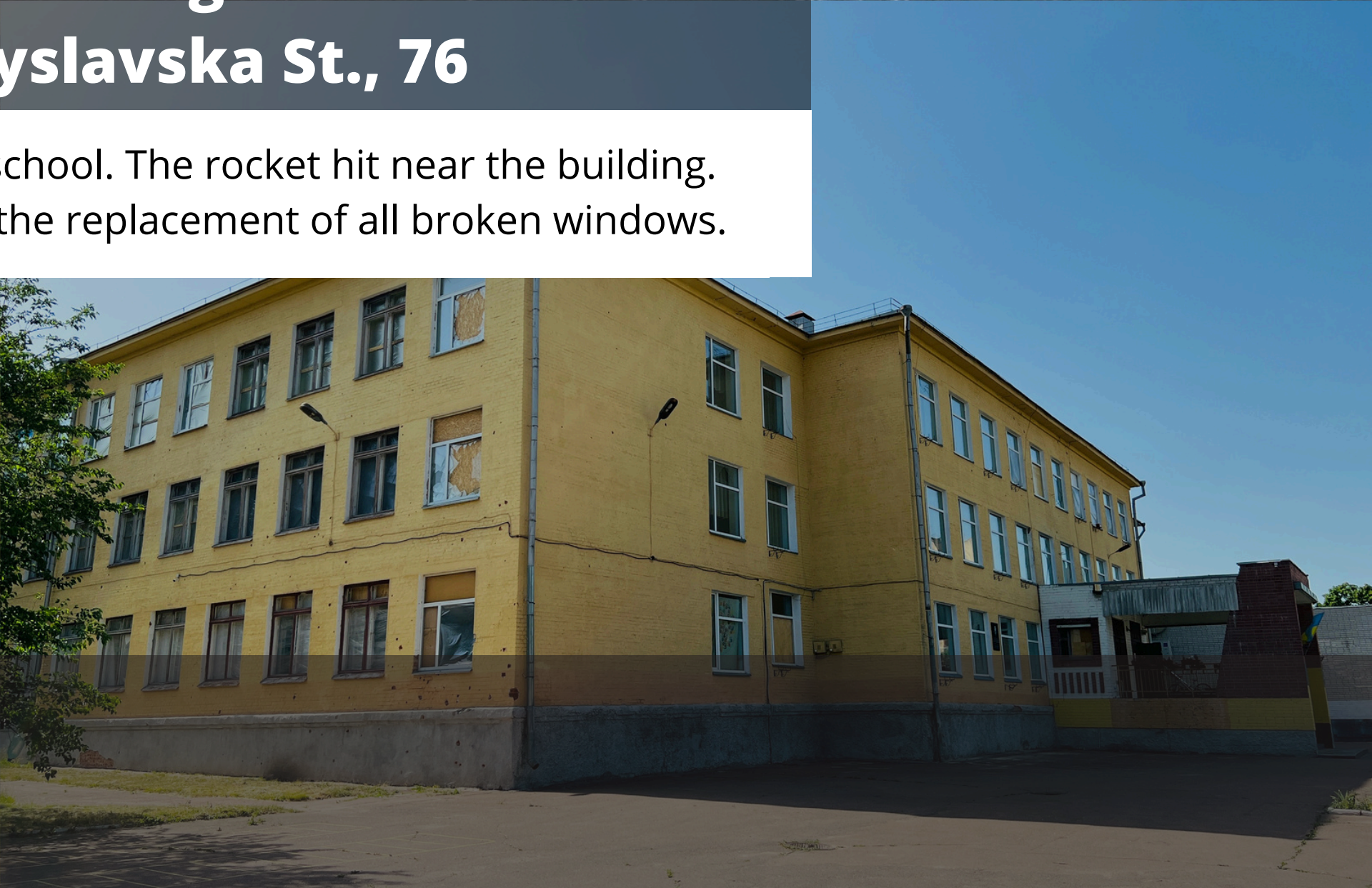
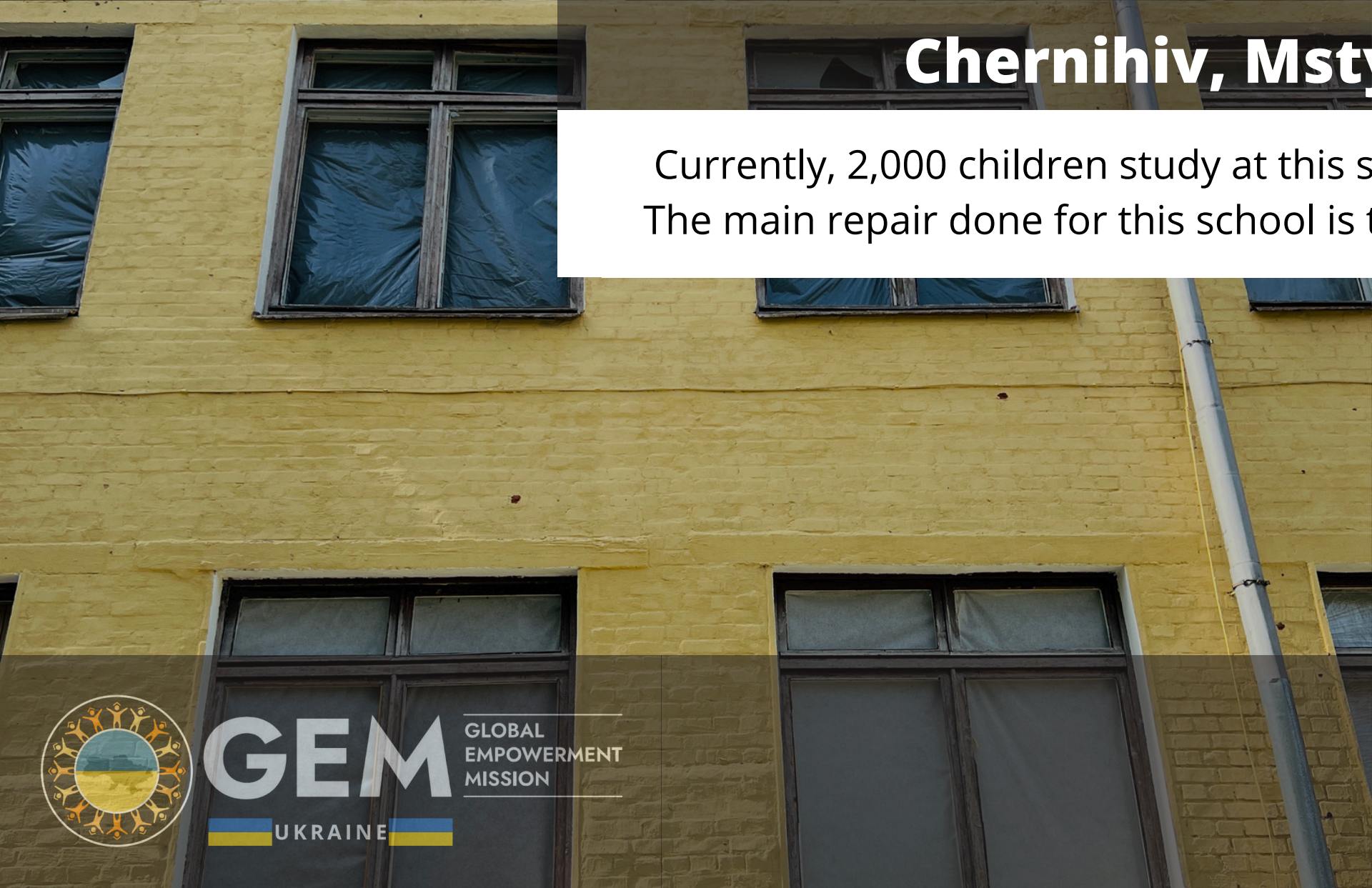

Currently, 2,000 children study at this school. The rocket hit near the building. The main repair done for this school is the replacement of all broken windows.





## 2 Residential buildings in Vinnytsia

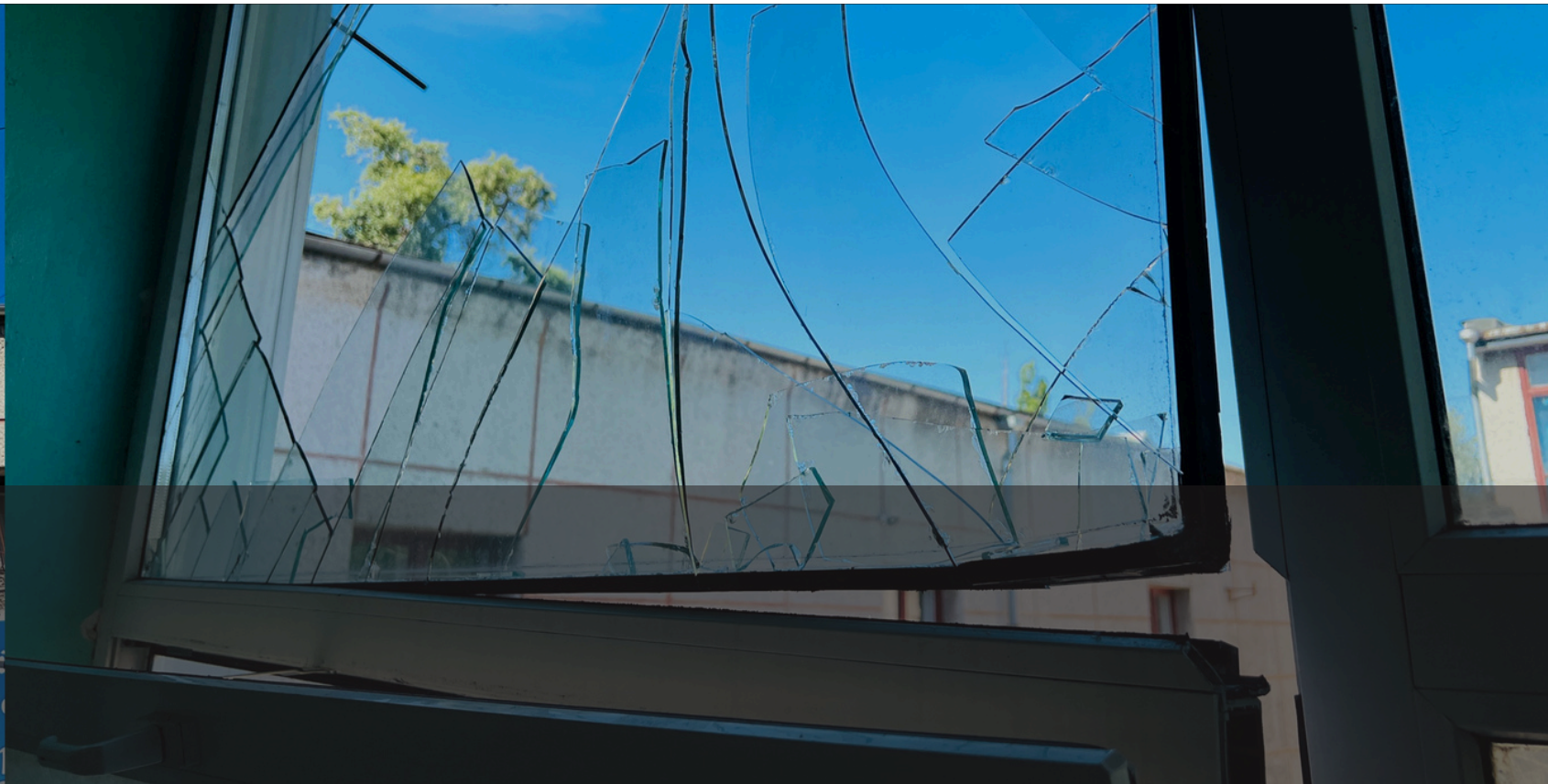
Restoration of windows in residential buildings in Vinnytsia that were damaged after missiles hit the city center.

# Psychoneurological boarding school Pushcha-Vodytsia, Miska St., 2

The main work on the hospital: replacement of windows and replacement of 850 m<sup>2</sup> roof. There is also a greenhouse on the territory, it produces the food for a special needs facility. This glass was destroyed by shelling.

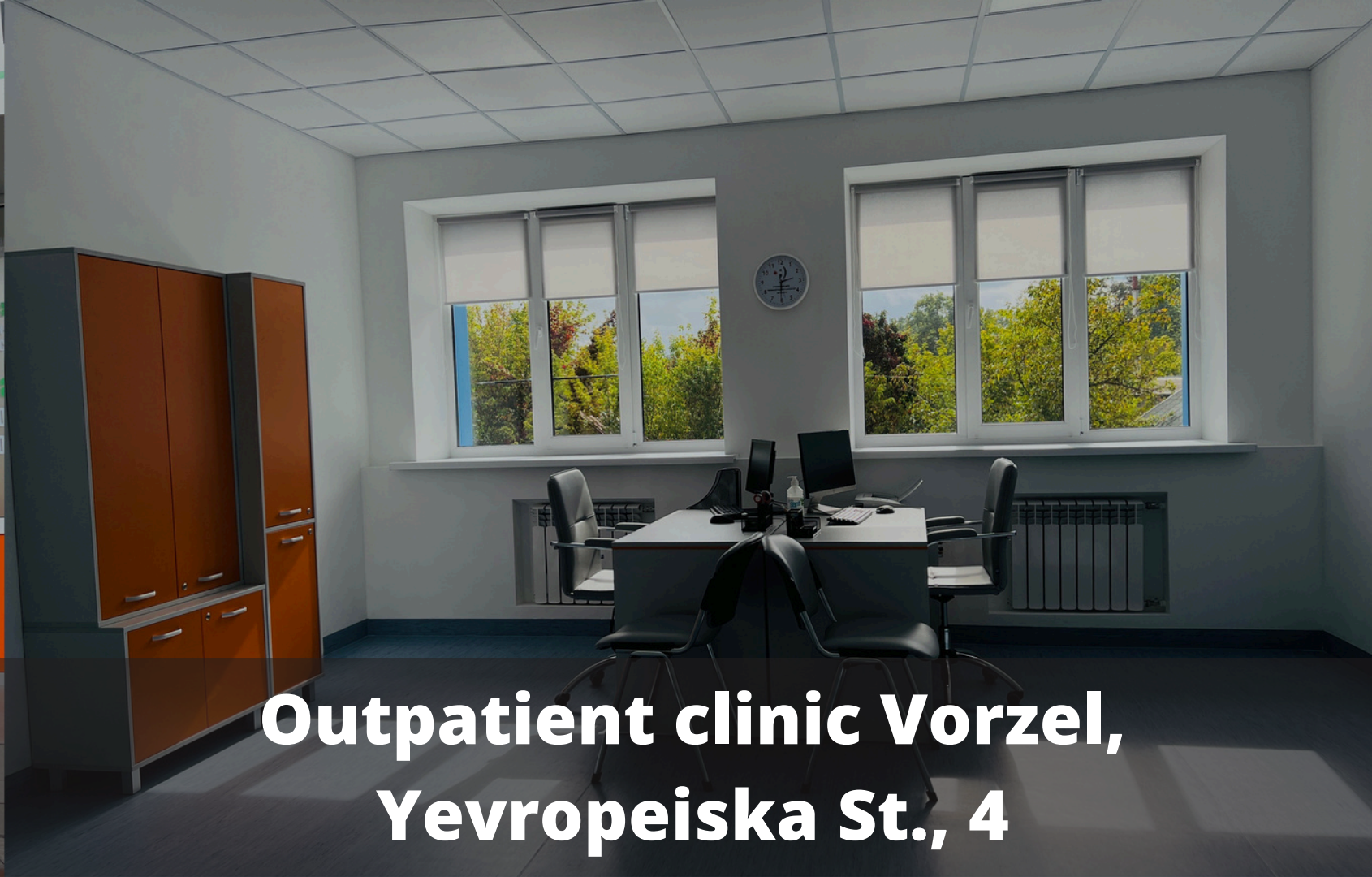




### 3 hospitals in Bucha district

Hospitals in Havrylivka village, Myrotske village and Zdvizhivka village that have suffered from missiles and occupations.  
Main works: replacement of windows, doors, facade.





## Outpatient clinic Vorzel, Yevropeiska St., 4

The outpatient clinic was repaired, as well as facade works, improvement of the territory and supply of furniture. More than 20 doctors work here, providing medical care to 10,000 patients.

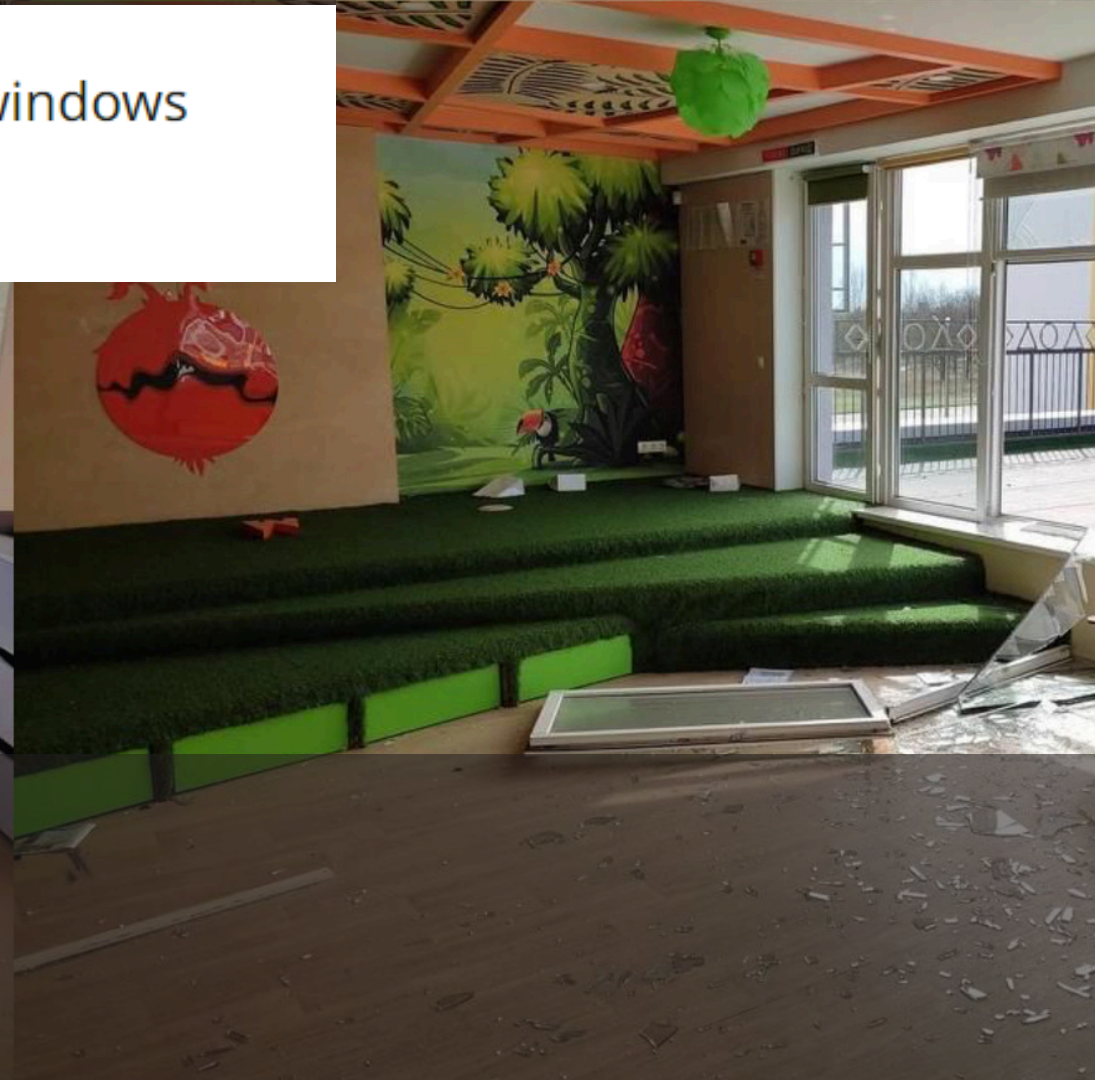






## "Limpopo" Kindergarten Bucha, Borys Hmyri St., 11A

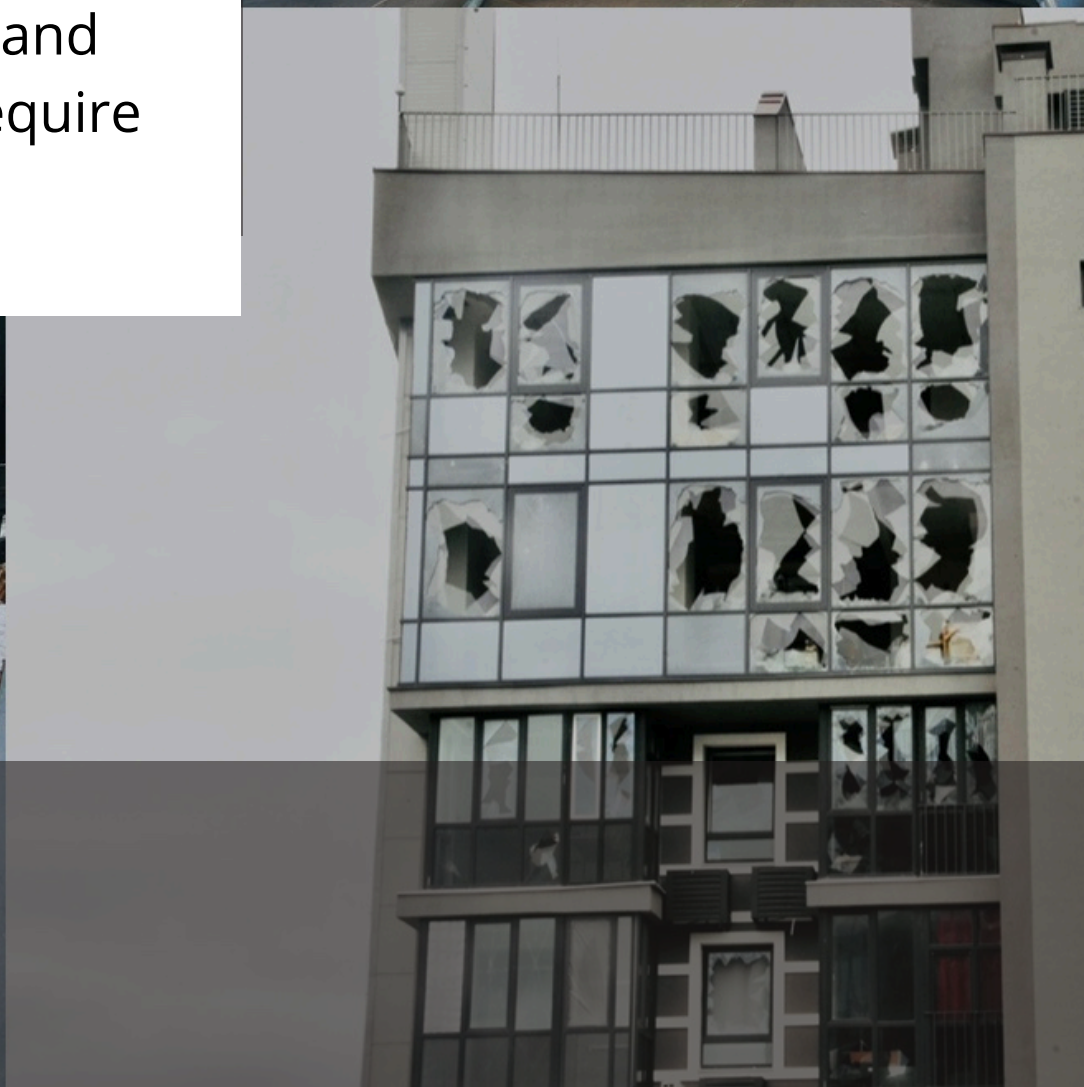
In total, there are 50-60 children in this kindergarten. During the fighting windows and the playground on the grounds were damaged.

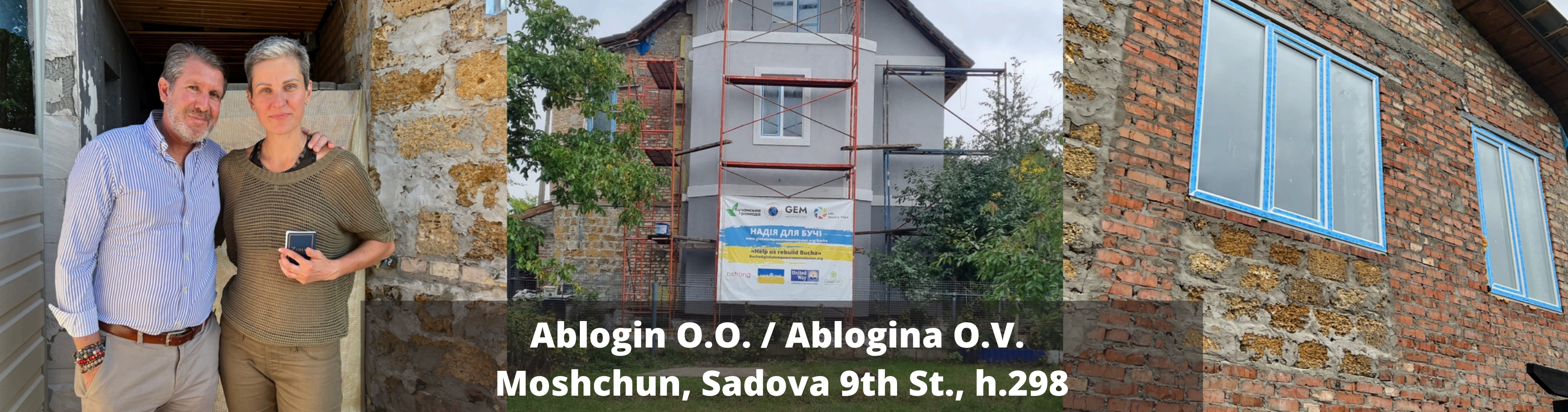




## RC Grand-Bourget Bucha, L. Biriukova Blvd., 2A

This complex consists of 2 buildings. Building 1 has 565 apartments, and building 2 has 458 apartments, both totalling 2,750 occupants. Both require replacement of windows, roof repairs, facade work and repair of the boiler room servicing the complex.





**Ablogin O.O. / Ablogina O.V.  
Moshchun, Sadova 9th St., h.298**

Repaired the Ablogin family residence which is located in the Moshchun village in the Bucha district. In this village, almost 95% of the houses were damaged or destroyed. This brave family hid in a 6 sq ft boiler room for a week with their neighbors. Several shells hit the house damaging windows, doors, and the roof. The family was fired upon but survived.

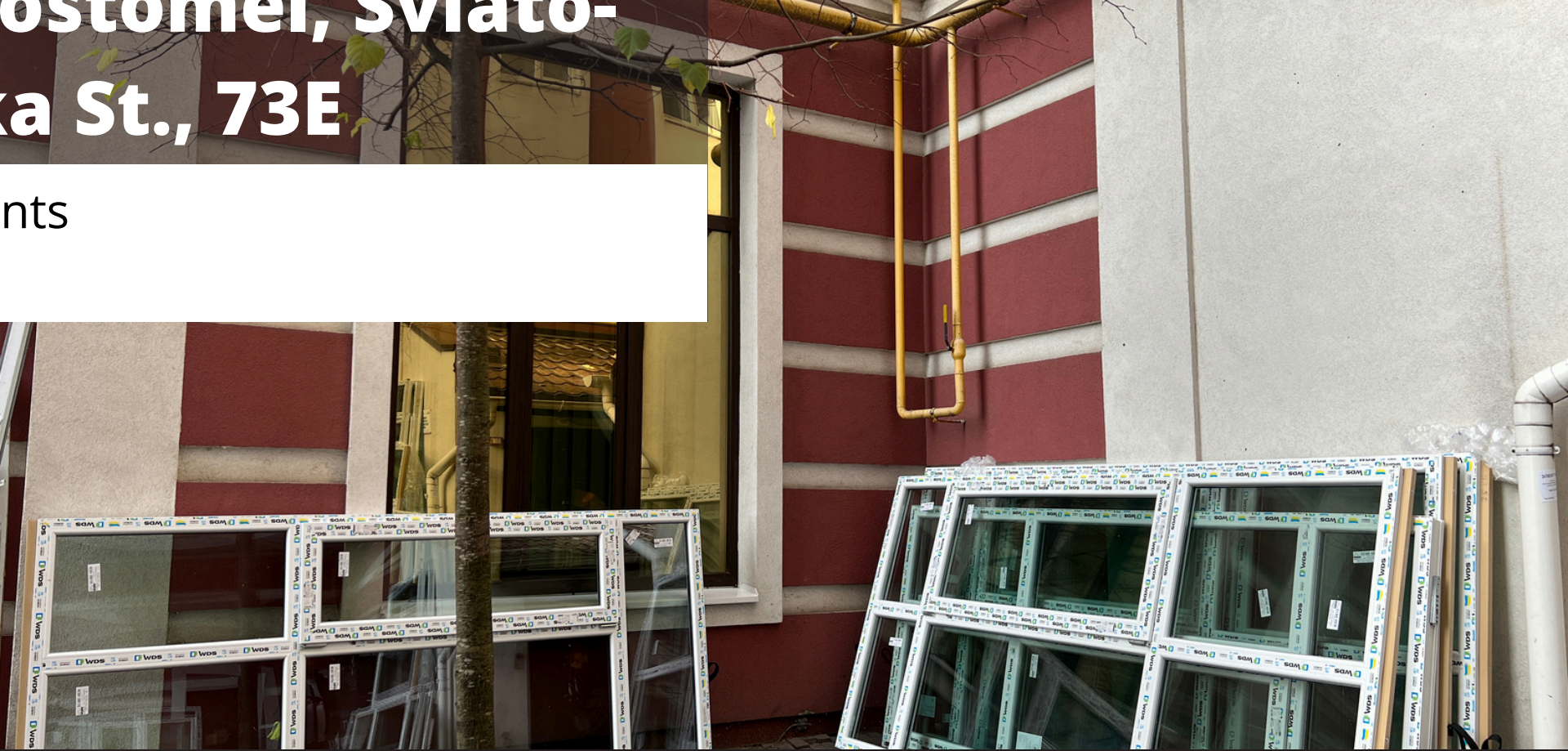
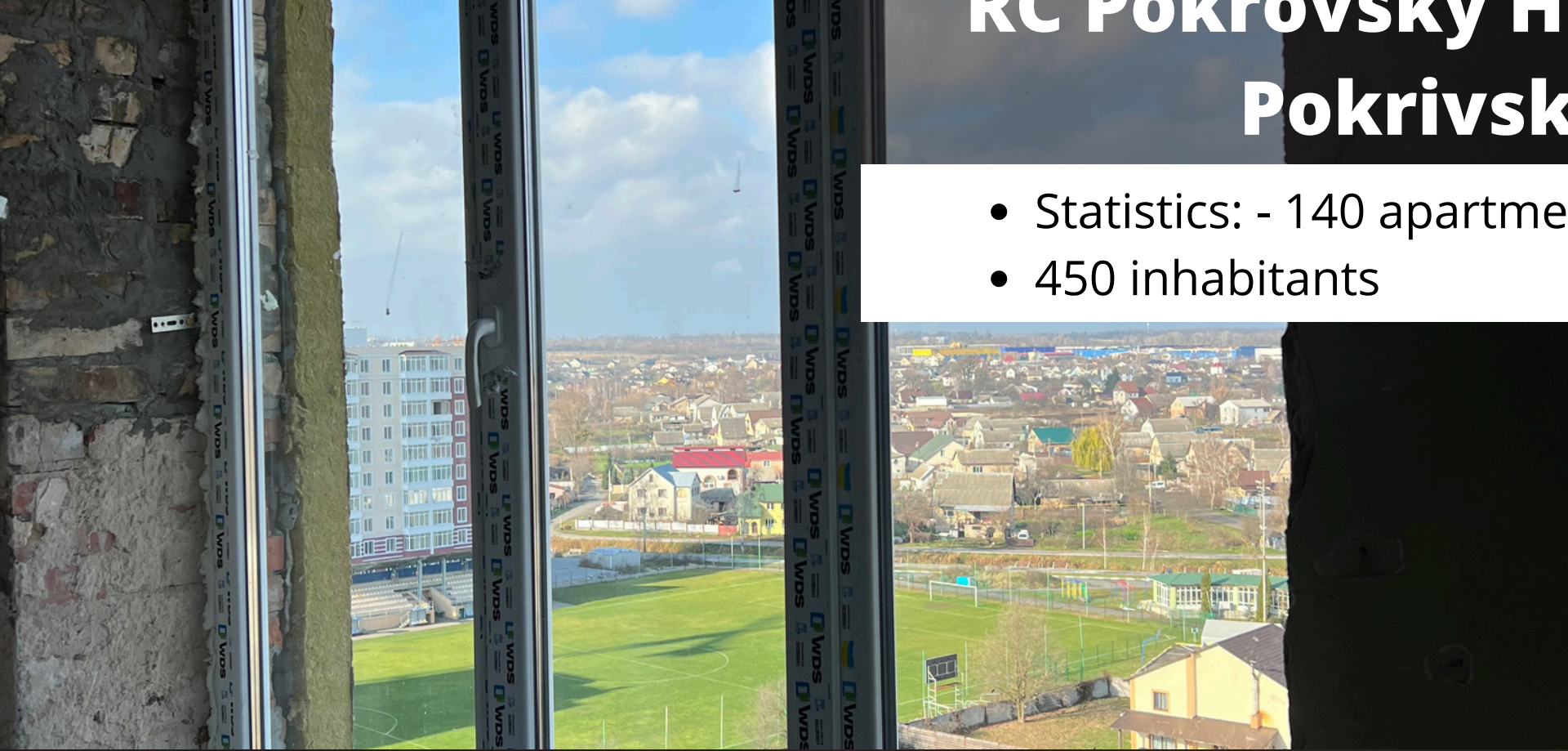
